


Picture in your mind that Hashem is watching everything you do.





Wherever a person goes, he should have in mind that he is standing before Hashem who is our King. People behave with more respect when standing in front of a King. So, if a person always keeps this in mind, the way he talks and acts will certainly change.

There is a custom to write the words "shivisi" etc. in shul, near the altar where the chazan stands. Many times the words are covered with glass, so that the name of Hashem should not be erased. This is done to remind a person about the important mitzvah of always remembering that Hashem is watching what we do.
