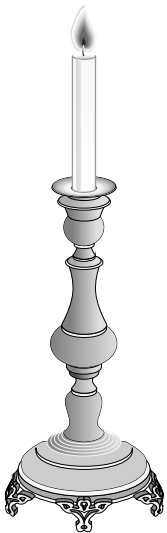




BAKING CHALLAH



Baking challah is a special way of honoring the Shabbos. After kneading the dough, a piece is separated for the mitzvah of "Challah". A bracha is said when we use approximately five or more

pounds of flour (4lbs. 15.2 oz. - 2.25kg). The bracha is: Baruch...vetzivanu lehafrish challah (some add: min ha'isa). The piece that we separated is either burned, wrapped up and placed in the trash, or buried.
